Minden, NV – Douglas County has activated a call center to allow the public to report non-emergency incidents related to the current flooding. Residents can call **775-783-6038** to report any non-emergency-related flood concerns. The call center is operational from 8 a.m. through 10 p.m. daily. For flood emergencies, please call 911.

The County has also opened a livestock evacuation center at the Douglas County Fairgrounds. Douglas County residents who need to evacuate livestock due to flooding can bring them to 920 Dump Rd, Gardnerville, NV 89410. Call 775-782-5126 to coordinate drop-off.
